

Through school and home-based education programs, Family Star Montessori achieved great successes throughout 2022.

KINDERGARTEN READINESS

From toddler exploration to school-aged expectations, Family Star fosters independence by focusing on practical life skills and advancing social/emotional learning, to academic preparedness that will help children thrive.

- 98% of 3-5 year-olds were meeting/exceeding **physical** expectations, which focuses on balance and coordination, personal care routines, manipulating smaller objects, and identifying healthy and unhealthy foods
- 87% of 3-5 year-olds were meeting/exceeding **cognitive** expectations where children can classify and sort objects, recognize and names shapes, knows 1-1 correspondence such as up and down
- 87% of 3-5 year-olds were meeting/exceeding cognitive expectations that they can develop friendships, know how to take turns and share, express emotions, can express emotions and respect, show belief in their abilities, and has a sense of accomplishment




